

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

As July comes to an end and a new school year approaches, many of us find ourselves caught up in planning, preparing, and managing full schedules. It is easy to get overwhelmed by the busy work of life. Last week's Gospel reading about Martha and Mary reminds us that while work has its place, we must also make time to sit with Jesus, as Mary did, and listen. In the midst of activity, we are called to remember what is truly essential.

The song Drawn to You by Sarah Hart speaks to this longing for stillness and presence. Its lyrics remind us that all we bring (our efforts, our gifts, or our time) find their meaning in relationship with God. When we center our hearts on Him, our everyday tasks become part of something sacred. God receives what we offer and transforms it into grace.

This week's Gospel about the loaves and fishes reinforces that truth. Even when what we have feels small or inadequate, God can make it more than enough. As we enter this new season, may we resist the pull to do everything on our own and instead let ourselves be drawn to the one who gives all things purpose and peace.
