

## G.P.'s Music Corner

August 3, 2025  
18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The song Bread of Angels takes the well loved text of Panis Angelicus and gives it a setting that feels prayerful and approachable. Panis Angelicus, written by Saint Thomas Aquinas, is one of the most cherished texts in Catholic liturgy because it speaks so beautifully about the mystery of the Eucharist, the Bread of Angels given to feed us. By including the Latin refrain in a simple and familiar way, the song connects us to the long tradition of the Church while letting us pray it in a style that feels natural for today. It is a bridge between what we have inherited from centuries past and how we continue to worship now.

What is especially moving about this song is how naturally it shifts between the solemn beauty of the Latin chant and the lyrical English verses. That movement almost mirrors the way the Mass itself brings together heaven and earth in the Communion rite. The music is gentle and flowing which helps people pray rather than focus on the performance. It works beautifully as a Communion song because it draws the congregation inward, encouraging reflection and quiet gratitude while staying rooted in tradition.
