On "You are Near"

The song **You Are Near** has always been close to my heart because I grew up listening to it and singing it at school liturgies and in church. Back then the lyrics used the name "Yahweh," which felt deeply personal and reverent. The name "Yahweh" itself carries so much meaning in Scripture, as it is the name God revealed to Moses, signifying His closeness and His covenant with His people. In our Catholic faith, names matter deeply because they speak to identity and relationship. To know someone's name is to be in communion with them, and to be called by name by God is a reminder that He knows us personally and invites us to love and serve Him in return.

Hearing **You Are Near** again today reminds me of how important it is for each generation to experience these timeless hymns. Even if some of the words have changed, the message of God's nearness and His intimate knowledge of us remains the same. It is beautiful to see children today still learning this song, singing about God's presence in their lives, and slowly understanding what it means to be called by name to follow Him. In this way, the song continues to nurture faith and guide hearts toward a life of love and service.
