On "Drawn to You"

Drawn to You by Sarah Hart has quickly become one of the most well loved new songs we have added to our parish's music rotation. Every time I select it for Mass, I notice how many people sing along and how the melody seems to rise naturally from the congregation. It makes me wonder what this song means to each person who sings it. Are they praying from a place of gratitude, of longing, or of struggle? The lyrics speak so openly about being pulled toward God's mercy and presence, and I imagine that each voice joining in carries its own story and its own prayer. As I lead this song, I quietly pray with and for the people I hear singing around me. I pray that the words meet them exactly where they need comfort or encouragement and that they feel God drawing near to them in that moment. It is a beautiful reminder that our parish family is united not only by the music we sing but also by the faith we share. In these moments, I catch a glimpse of the communion we long for: one with hearts turned toward God, singing together as one.
