


Irish Blessing

In 1 Timothy 6:11-16, Paul encourages us to chase after righteousness, faith, love, patience, and gentleness, and to hold on tightly to the faith we profess. Those words make me think of my dad. His birthday is on October 1st, and I find myself thinking about him often. He was a good man who showed his faith by the way he cared for our family. He was steady, he was righteous, and he let his three boys live their lives in their own way.
