

G.P.'s Music Corner

October 12, 2025

28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings today remind us that it is not always easy to recognize God's goodness when the world feels so full of suffering and injustice. Naaman was healed of his leprosy, and the ten lepers in the Gospel were cleansed, yet only one returned to give thanks. Gratitude is not automatic, especially when daily life confronts us with violence, dishonesty, and leaders who ignore the values of truth and mercy. In such a world, it is tempting to overlook or even doubt the ways God is working quietly among us.

Paul's letter to Timothy points us back to endurance and faith in Christ, who remains faithful even when we falter. The hymns "You Alone" and "Be Not Afraid" draw us into this same response. They remind us that God's presence is real even when obscured by hardship, and that gratitude is an act of faith that pushes back against despair. To sing these hymns is to proclaim that we will not let the injustice of the world blind us to the mercy of God, who continues to heal, strengthen, and remain with His people.

Throughout October, we will be transitioning to a new mass setting called "Mass of Glory (which can be found in our hymnal starting at song #882)." Every week, we will switch out one mass part until we fully transition by November.
