**G.P.'s Music Corner**

**October 19, 2025**  
29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings this Sunday teach us about perseverance in prayer and fidelity to God. Moses, standing on the hilltop, cannot keep his arms raised alone, yet with the help of Aaron and Hur, Israel prevails. Paul urges Timothy to remain rooted in Scripture, proclaiming the word with steadfastness. Jesus, in the parable of the persistent widow, assures us that God hears those who cry out to Him day and night, and that we must not lose heart even when the answer seems slow. Together, these passages show us that prayer, Scripture, and community give us the strength to endure.

Sarah Hart's "*Healed in Christ*" captures this same journey of faith, not only in its words but also in its music. It begins with a sparse, simple texture that mirrors the vulnerability of Moses standing alone or the widow crying out in her loneliness. The lyrics invite us to bring our wounds and burdens before Christ, trusting that He is present even in silence. As the song builds toward its repetitive and climactic bridge, the persistence of faith is made audible: like the widow who will not give up, the music insists on hope and presses forward with determination. Then, as the song returns to a quiet and sparse ending, we are reminded that healing often comes gently, restoring us to peace. The hymn's shape mirrors the readings' message: faith begins in weakness, grows strong through persistence, and finds resolution in God's healing presence.

Throughout October, we will be transitioning to a new mass setting called "Mass of Glory (which can be found in our hymnal starting at song #882)." Every week, we will switch out one mass part until we fully transition by November.
