This weekend we sing *Jesus, You Are the Healing* by Scott Soper, a song I especially enjoy programming for the liturgy. From my vantage point at the piano, I often notice that the congregation sings out a bit more when we pray with gospel-tinged music like this. There is something about its steady, repetitive rhythms that feels like a persistent prayer, a musical echo of the way we return again and again to God with our needs, our hopes, and our trust.

Each verse ends with the plea, "come show us how to live," reminding us that Christ not only heals us, but sends us out to be His healing presence in the world.
