

# G.P.'s Music Corner

February 8, 2026

**5th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

"Here I am, Lord." Few hymns capture the heart of vocation as simply and honestly as *Here I Am, Lord*. It is a song about hearing God's voice and choosing how to respond, not with certainty or a detailed plan, but with availability.

When I play this hymn, I do not follow the harmony exactly as it appears in the official sheet music. Over time, I have quietly adjusted it. The harmonies are shaped to feel as if they are growing, moving, almost marching forward. I wanted the music itself to suggest what the text proclaims: that answering God's call is not static. It is an unfolding, a willingness that gathers strength as we step into it.

I play this song often because it is frequently requested at funerals. In those moments, the words take on particular weight. They are sung in the presence of grief, memory, and hope. I have often wondered whether people notice the subtle musical change, or whether they simply feel something shifting beneath the familiar melody. Perhaps that is enough. The response to God's call is not always loud or obvious. Sometimes it begins quietly, almost unnoticed, but still real.

On this Sunday, the readings remind us that God continues to call ordinary people to do extraordinary things. The question is not whether God is speaking, but whether we are willing to answer. "Here I am, Lord" is more than a refrain. It is a posture of the heart, one that asks us not only to listen, but to move forward in faith, even when the path ahead is not fully clear.
