

# G.P.'s Music Corner

6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

February 15

As we celebrate the 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time, we also find ourselves at a turning point in the Church year. Ordinary Time is not called "ordinary" because it is unimportant or routine. The word comes from *ordinal, meaning counted or ordered. These weeks are about the steady, faithful unfolding of Christ's ministry and our own growth as disciples. As this stretch of Ordinary Time comes to a close, the Church gently prepares us to shift from watching and learning to examining and responding.*

That shift is especially noticeable in the music. During Ordinary Time, our song often carries a sense of openness, confidence, and forward motion. The melodies are meant to support proclamation and everyday discipleship. As we move into Lent, the musical language changes. Textures become simpler, harmonies more restrained, and silence more intentional. The music turns inward, inviting reflection, repentance, and honesty before God. This change is not meant to diminish joy, but to focus it, so that when Easter arrives, the return of full sound and song feels earned, truthful, and deeply alive.
