G.P.'s Music Corner

March 1, 2026

2nd Sunday of Lent

For the season of Lent, you may notice a subtle musical change. We are using the *Mass of Creation*, whose minor key setting offers a more somber and reflective character that is especially fitting for this penitential season.

Our Communion song, *Transfigure Us, O Lord* by Bob Hurd, beautifully reflects today's Gospel. The music shifts between two keys in the refrain and verses, musically echoing the mystery of the Transfiguration and inviting us into that moment of spiritual transformation.

At the Family Mass, we sing *Beyond the Days* by Ricky Manalo, which connects closely to the readings for the Second Sunday of Lent. The text reminds us that the Lenten journey calls us to look beyond the present moment in trust and hope as we follow Christ toward new life.
