G.P.'s Music Corner

4th Sunday of Lent | March 15

For the Fourth Sunday of Lent (Cycle A), our music reflects the Gospel's powerful movement from blindness to sight. The traditional hymn *Amazing Grace* gives voice to this journey of awakening: "I once was lost, but now am found, was blind but now I see." The story of the man born blind reminds us that grace opens our eyes to recognize Christ more fully.

Rooted deeply in American history and culture, *Amazing Grace* has become a spiritual touchstone across generations, traditions, and communities. Its enduring place in our shared musical heritage underscores the universality of the Gospel message. Just as the man in the Gospel gradually comes to see and believe, the hymn invites us to notice the quiet, persistent work of grace in our own lives this Lent.

This week we also celebrate the Solemnity of Saint Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The readings highlight Joseph's quiet righteousness and faithful obedience to God's plan. As a carpenter, Joseph was the one who taught Jesus how to work with his hands, shaping wood and building with care and patience. In a profound way, the one who helped Jesus learn to build earthly things also helped prepare him for his mission of building up the Kingdom of God. Joseph's faithful response mirrors the spirit of the hymn *Here I Am, Lord*, reminding us that God's work often begins with a humble and trusting yes.

As we reflect this week, consider: In what ways have we as a society been blind? In what ways are we as believers blind? In what ways might God be giving us new vision? And what is God asking us to build as a nation and as his people?
