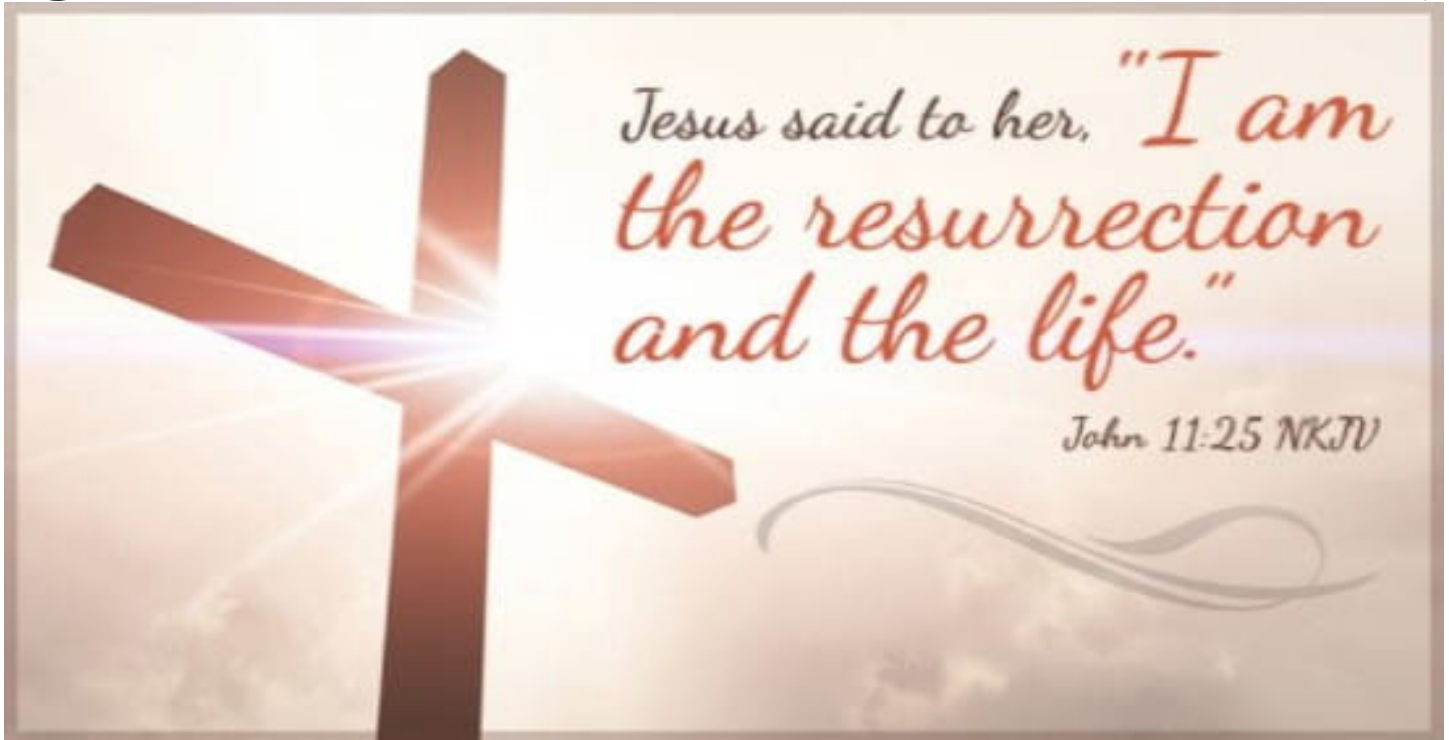

Every good friend is an image of God. It is one of life's best blessings.

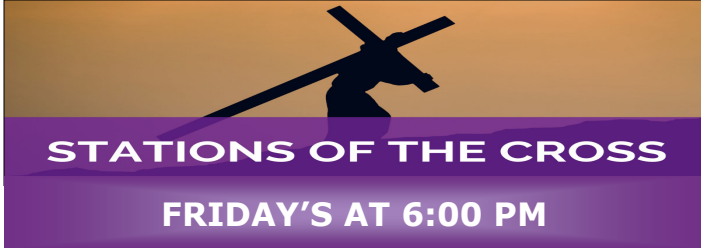
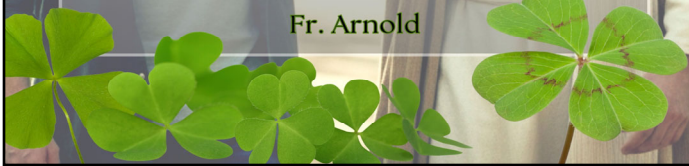
Let us count our blessings not our burdens. Let us find time to thank God for all of his blessings.

G.P.'s Music Corner

5th Sunday of Lent | March 22

For the Fifth Sunday of Lent (Cycle A), the readings draw us into the mystery of new life that God brings even from places of death and despair. Our song *Christ in Me Arise gives musical voice to this movement, praying that Christ's life and power may be fully alive within us. As we hear the story of Lazarus and the promise of resurrection, the hymn reminds us that Christ is already at work in the hidden places of our lives, calling us toward renewal.*

Later this week, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation. Whenever a solemnity occurs during Lent, the Church briefly sets aside the more penitential tone because solemnities are among the highest-ranked celebrations in the liturgical year. They always highlight a central mystery of our salvation, and the Church marks them with a spirit of reverent joy even within penitential seasons.

The Annunciation shows us the model of perfect trust in God's plan. Mary's courageous yes allowed Christ to take flesh in the world. As we approach Holy Week through the Fifth Sunday of Lent, both the raising of Lazarus and Mary's fiat invite us to the same response. Like the prayer of *Christ in Me Arise, we are called to allow Christ to live and act within us, trusting that God is already bringing new life from whatever feels sealed or uncertain in our hearts.*
