G.P.'s Music Corner

Palm Sunday begins with a contradiction. We cry "Hosanna" to a king, yet within days the crowd will turn to "Crucify him." The liturgy confronts how quickly hope can give way to fear, and how easily people are swept into cycles of violence.

That same tension is visible today in the Middle East. Deep wounds, fear, and the pursuit of justice can harden into retaliation. Real suffering exists on all sides, yet the cycle continues.

Jesus enters into that kind of world. Jerusalem was tense and divided, but he does not meet violence with violence. He chooses humility and self-giving love.

Palm Sunday asks us to do the same. Not to ignore suffering, but to resist the instinct toward retaliation in our own lives. As we enter Holy Week, we are invited to confront both the brokenness of the world and our place within it, and to choose the path Christ shows: not vengeance, but mercy; not despair, but hope.
