G.P.'s Music Corner

April 12, 2026
Divine Mercy Sunday Reflection
Second Sunday of Easter

Today the Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday, given to us through the visions of St. Faustina and placed on the Second Sunday of Easter by St. John Paul II. It is fitting that this feast stands so close to the Resurrection. The mercy that flows from the pierced side of Christ is the very mercy revealed in the empty tomb.

In today's Gospel, the risen Jesus enters the locked room of the disciples and speaks words the Church still needs to hear: "Peace be with you." He does not return in anger or reproach, but in mercy. Divine Mercy Sunday reminds us that no failure, no doubt, and no fear is greater than the love of the Risen Lord.

As we lift our voices in song today, I invite you to pray the music, not just sing it. Listen for the themes of trust, forgiveness, and hope. Let the words we proclaim together become your personal prayer: Jesus, I trust in You. May the mercy of the Risen Christ fill our parish, renew our hearts, and strengthen us to be instruments of that same mercy in the world.
