## G.P.'s Music Corner

May 3, 2026

5th Sunday of Easter

"In the House That Love Is Building," a song by Sarah Hart, offers a simple but profound image of the Church. It is not static. It is being built.

Anyone involved in parish life sees this clearly. There is always some form of construction underway. Roofs are repaired. Walls are repainted. Floors are replaced. New spaces are added, from prayer gardens to grottos, each one meant to draw people more deeply into encounter with God. Even subtle changes in the sanctuary or gathering space reflect an ongoing effort to make the church a place that better serves worship and community.

This constant building is not merely practical. It points to something deeper. Every physical improvement carries a quiet hope that a spiritual rebuilding is happening at the same time.

The Church is not only the structure we gather in. It is the people who gather there. Just as the building requires care, attention, and renewal, so do our hearts. The work is ongoing. It is sometimes slow. It can be costly. But it is necessary.

This is where the image of Christ as carpenter becomes especially meaningful. Before His public ministry, Jesus worked with His hands, shaping wood into something useful and enduring. That same care and intention is directed toward us. He works patiently within our lives, strengthening what is weak, repairing what is broken, and shaping us into something that can hold His love.

The goal is not perfection of the building alone, but transformation of the people within it. A beautifully renovated church means little if the community inside remains unchanged. The deeper calling is that, as the walls are restored and spaces renewed, our hearts are also being formed into a dwelling place worthy of God.

In the end, the house that love is building is both visible and invisible. It is the church we see, and the lives we live. Both are under construction. Both are guided by the same builder. And both are meant to reflect the beauty of His love.
