Solemnity of the Ascension

"One Sacrifice of Christ," by Rick Modlin, draws our attention to a central truth of the faith: Christ's sacrifice is not repeated, but made present. It is one, complete, and eternal. Each time we gather for the Eucharist, we are not witnessing something new, but entering into that same sacrifice.

This truth connects directly to the Solemnity of the Ascension. When Jesus ascended into heaven, He did not simply "leave." According to Catholic teaching, the Ascension marks His exaltation and His entrance into the heavenly sanctuary, where He intercedes for us. His sacrifice, offered once on the cross, is now presented eternally before the Father.

This is why the Eucharist matters so deeply. The Mass unites heaven and earth. The same Christ who ascended is truly present, and we are drawn into His offering. The Ascension is not distance, but access. Christ is not absent. He is present in a new and profound way.

The implications for daily life are concrete. If Christ is truly reigning and interceding, then our lives are meant to be oriented toward that reality. We are called to live with a sense of purpose and hope, knowing that our work, our struggles, and even our suffering can be united to His one sacrifice. Nothing is wasted when it is offered to Him.

The Ascension also reminds us of our destination. Where Christ has gone, we are called to follow. Our lives are not only about what is here and now, but about being drawn into the life of heaven even now, through grace.

As we reflect on this feast and the music that accompanies it, we are reminded that the "one sacrifice of Christ" is not a distant event. It is a living reality, one that continues to shape the Church and call each of us into deeper union with Him.
