G.P.'s Music Corner

May 24, 2026

Pentecost Sunday

Pentecost is often marked by dramatic images: wind, fire, and voices speaking in many tongues. But at its core is something quieter and more fundamental. Breath.

In Scripture, the breath of God is life itself. In the beginning, God breathes life into humanity. After the Resurrection, Jesus breathes on His disciples and gives them the Holy Spirit. At Pentecost, that same Spirit fills the Church, not as a one-time event, but as an ongoing reality. The Church teaches that Pentecost is the moment the Church is made visible and sent into the world, sustained always by the Spirit who gives it life.

Breath is also what makes singing possible. Every note we sing begins with breath. When a congregation sings together, it is not just a collection of individual voices, but a shared act of breathing, phrasing, and offering. In a very real way, our song becomes a sign of the Spirit at work among us, drawing many voices into one.

This particular weekend holds that image in a unique way. We celebrate the graduation of our 8th grade students, marking a moment of transition and new beginnings. We also stand near Memorial Day, remembering those who have given their lives in service. One moment looks forward, the other looks back. Pentecost stands between them, reminding us that in every season, it is the breath of God that sustains us.

Whether in moments of change, remembrance, or ordinary daily life, the same Spirit is at work. The invitation is simple: to receive that breath, and to let it shape how we live, speak, and even sing.
