G.P.'s Music Corner

The Most Holy Trinity

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity invites us to reflect on one of the central mysteries of the Catholic faith: one God in three Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This is not a puzzle to be solved, but a reality to be received. The Church teaches that God is not solitude, but communion. From all eternity, the Father, Son, and Spirit exist in perfect relationship, a unity of love that is complete and life-giving.

This matters because we are made in that image. To believe in the Trinity is to believe that we are created for relationship: with God and with one another. Faith is not meant to remain private or contained. It is something that moves outward.

That sense of being sent is especially visible this time of year. Our students have completed another school year and are stepping into summer, some moving on to new schools and new responsibilities. Others in our parish are beginning travel, family gatherings, or simply a different rhythm of life. There is a natural sense of going forth.

The Trinity offers a way to understand that movement. The Son is sent by the Father. The Spirit is sent into the world. God's very life is one of sending and being sent in love. When we are sent into our daily lives, whether into classrooms, workplaces, or summer plans, we share in that same pattern.

This means summer is not a pause from faith, but a different setting for it. The relationships we invest in, the time we give to others, and the way we carry ourselves all become part of how we reflect the life of the Trinity.

As we celebrate this feast, we are reminded that we do not go out alone. We are sent by a God who is communion, and we are called to reflect that communion wherever we go.
