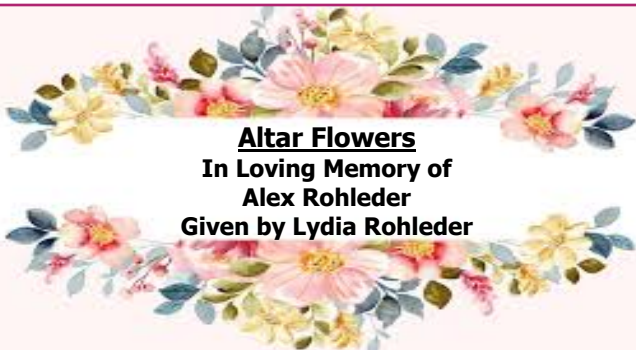

G.P.'s Music Corner

July 12, 2026

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Every Sunday, we gather to hear God's Word, but today's readings invite us to ask a deeper question: How well do we receive it? In the Parable of the Sower, Jesus reminds us that the same seed is scattered everywhere, yet it bears fruit differently depending on the soil that receives it. Isaiah offers us great hope by assuring us that God's Word is never wasted. It always accomplishes His purpose, often in ways we don't immediately see.

That's the thread running through our music this weekend. We begin by singing "Tend the Ground", asking God to soften whatever has become hardened in our hearts so His Word may take root. During Communion, "Open My Eyes" becomes our prayer that we might recognize God's presence not only here in church but throughout the week ahead. And as we leave singing "Alleluia, Raise the Gospel", we're reminded that the Word we've heard isn't meant to stay inside these walls. It is a gift to be lived, shared, and proclaimed by the way we love one another.

As you sing "Tend the Ground" today, ask the Lord to make your heart a place where His Word can take root and bear lasting fruit.
