G.P.'s Music Corner

July 19, 2026

16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

One of the most comforting themes in today's readings is God's patience. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the wheat and the weeds, reminding us that God doesn't give up on His people. Rather than rushing to judgment, He patiently continues His work of bringing goodness out of imperfect lives. The first reading echoes that same truth, telling us that God's strength is shown most beautifully through His mercy.

Our music reflects that patient love. "Seed, Scattered and Sown" reminds us that God never stops planting seeds of faith, even when growth seems slow. "Shelter Me, O God" gives voice to the trust that He remains with us through every season of life, while "Endless Is Your Love" celebrates the mercy we encounter most profoundly in the Eucharist. As we sing "Go Out, Go Out" at the end of Mass, may we carry that same patience into our families, our workplaces, and our parish, trusting that God is still quietly at work in every heart, including our own.

As we sing "Go Out, Go Out", consider one simple way you can reflect God's patient love to someone this week.
