G.P.'s Music Corner

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

If someone asked us what we treasure most, our answers would probably reveal a great deal about our lives. In today's Gospel, Jesus compares the Kingdom of Heaven to a treasure hidden in a field and a pearl of great price, something so valuable that everything else becomes secondary. Solomon's prayer in the first reading points us in the same direction. Instead of asking for riches or success, he asks God for wisdom, recognizing that the greatest gifts are the ones that draw us closer to Him.

Today's music invites us to make that same choice. "Come, Now Is the Time to Worship" gathers us around what truly matters, while "Drawn to You" expresses the desire that brings each of us to this celebration: to know Christ more deeply. At Communion, we receive the greatest treasure we could ever possess in the Eucharist, making "Be Not Afraid" a fitting reminder that Christ Himself goes with us wherever we go. As we conclude with "O God Beyond All Praising", may our gratitude continue beyond this hour and shape the way we live throughout the coming week.

When we sing "Be Not Afraid" during Communion, let those familiar words become Christ's own promise to walk beside you in the week ahead.
