**August 2, 2026 –
Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

This Sunday's readings remind us that God alone satisfies the deepest hunger of the human heart. Through Isaiah, the Lord invites everyone to "come to the water" and receive freely what truly gives life. In the Gospel, Jesus feeds the multitude with only five loaves and two fish, revealing that God's generosity is never measured by scarcity but by abundance.

Our opening hymn, Come to the Feast, echoes this same invitation. God welcomes everyone to His table, not because we have earned a place, but because His love is freely given. Later, as we sing A Place at Your Table and conclude with I Am the Bread of Life, we are reminded that every celebration of the Eucharist is Christ's answer to humanity's deepest hunger.

May today's liturgy renew our confidence that no earthly success, possession, or accomplishment can satisfy us as completely as the Bread of Life who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist.
