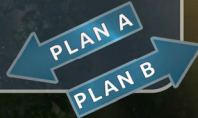
Dear St. Robert's parishioners and friends,

August 16, 2026 – Solemnity of the Assumption (Option A)

Today the Church celebrates the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, rejoicing that the Mother of God now shares fully in the glory of her Son. Mary's life was marked not by earthly power, but by complete trust in God's will. Her "yes" became the doorway through which salvation entered the world, and today we celebrate the fulfillment of God's promises to her.

Our music reflects this joyful hope. We begin with The House That Love Is Building, reminding us that God continues to build His family through faithful disciples like Mary. During Communion we sing Healed in Christ, recalling that Christ's victory over sin and death is already fully realized in His Blessed Mother. Finally, Hallelujah, Salvation and Glory proclaims the heavenly triumph we celebrate today.

As we honor Mary, may her example encourage each of us to trust God's plan, knowing that every act of faithful discipleship leads us closer to the eternal life Christ has prepared for His people.
