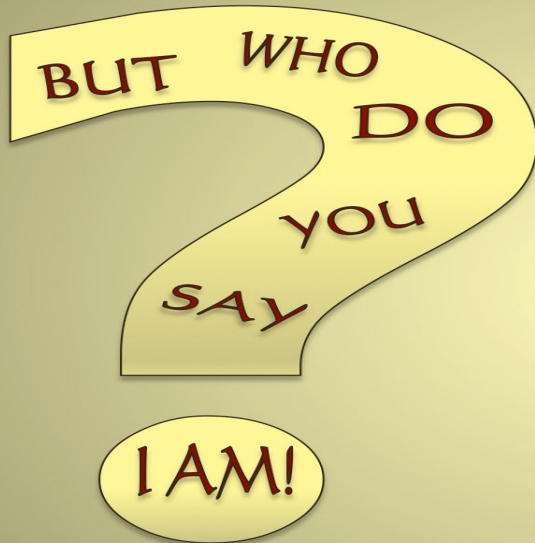

August 23, 2026 – Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time
