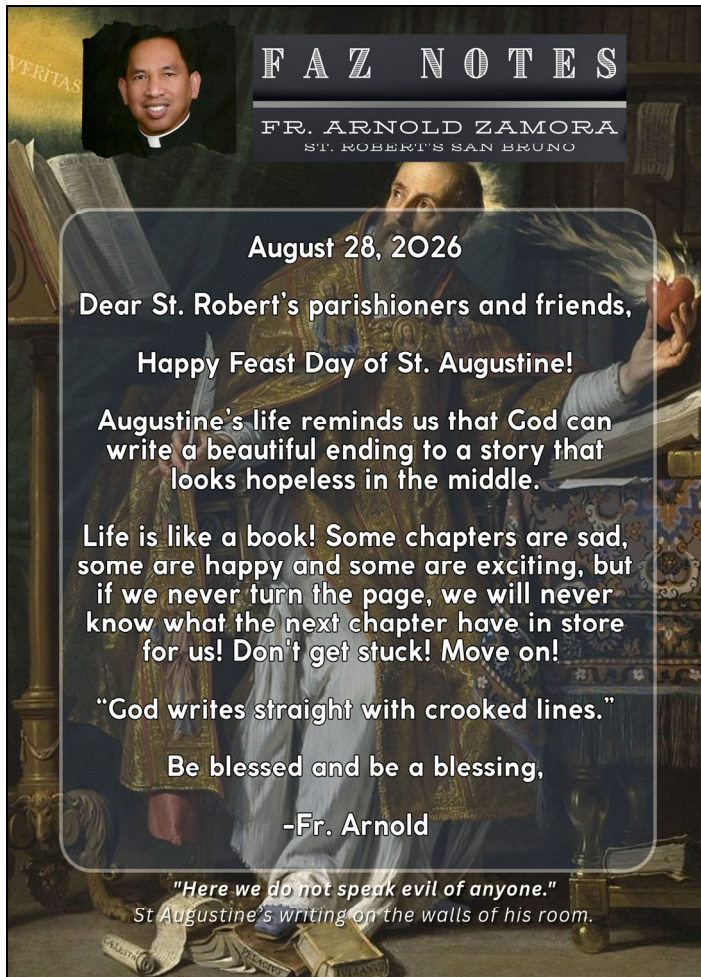
There is a six month period of preparation for the

G.P.'s Music Corner

August 30, 2026 – Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples that following Him requires more than admiration. It requires self-denial, taking up one's cross, and allowing our lives to be transformed by God's will. Jeremiah describes God's word as a fire burning within him, while St. Paul urges us to become living sacrifices, offering ourselves completely to the Lord.

Our music echoes this call to discipleship. We begin by singing Lift High the Cross, proclaiming that the cross is not merely a symbol of suffering but the sign of Christ's victory and our hope. During the Preparation of the Gifts, Only This I Want expresses the desire to seek Christ above every earthly pursuit. Finally, A Rightful Place reminds us that our true home is found not in worldly success, but within the Kingdom of God.

As we conclude both this month and the summer season, may today's Eucharist renew our courage to follow Christ faithfully, trusting that every sacrifice made for His sake leads ultimately to the fullness of life He promises.
