September 13, 2026 — 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Spirit Mass)

The start of a new school year always brings a familiar mix of energy, anticipation, and early-morning nerves. This weekend marks our Spirit Mass, the first of our school-sponsored Family Masses. It arrives at just the right moment, offering a chance to step back, take a breath, and lean into the boundless mercy and patience that the scriptures describe.
